We recently changed our services to help minister to the four groups of people we have in our area. Those groups are: Icelandic speaking adults with children who come to church as a family, Icelandic speaking bus kids, Icelandic teenagers, and the international English-speaking immigrants. Each of these groups have a service time where we minister to them on their level and attempt to see people saved, baptized, and disciplined to a place of maturity. Each group has its own challenges. Thank you for praying for these four groups as we do our best, with God's help, to reach them all for Christ. Ministering as a missionary is nothing like I thought it would be as I was on deputation nearly twenty-two years ago. I have seen God open doors and shut them. We discovered that God takes an active part in the work, and we must be sensitive to His leadership.
