It takes time to learn Icelandic. During this time of learning Icelandic, we offer English services. Many who attend these services are seeking assylm. It is a transient ministry. Please pray as we have over 19 countries and cultures currently attending services. It is a very complex ministry as most understand only conversational English at best. Most cannot read or write in English. This makes ministry quite challenging. **Bus ministry:** (Photo below) During summer time we always see a drop in attendance as families in Europe are know for taking 4-6 weeks of vacation. The kids are also sent to visit family. We are thankful for a good core of kids that are faithful to attend. We look forward to having them attend camp in July and spending a week discipling them. **Summer**



Camp: We are expecting 30 children in our camp this year with 10 workers. We will be 40 sleeping in the church for a week. Thank you for praying for this outreach. The children attending are from our Bus Ministry. We have a closed camp. It is a six-day camp where we provide meals and a full Bible-packed program for the whole six days and nights.
