



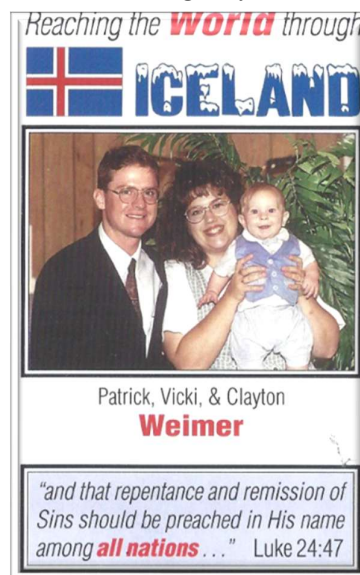
"The Northern Light" - Iceland News *The Weimer Family* *Reaching the World through Iceland*



What a joy to see **two mothers** of bus children profess their faith in Jesus and be **baptized** on Easter Sunday. As these moms began attending services over the past year, it has been a joy to see them learn of Christ. May marks eight years since our supporters helped us purchase an eighteen-passenger

minibus. That bus has carried thousands of souls to church. I am so thankful to those who sacrificed for us to get the bus. During the week of Easter/Passover, I had the joy of teaching through the Exodus memorial celebration called Passover and the Feast of Unleavened Bread, showing Jesus as our Passover. "For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us" (1 Corinthians 5:7). We met together each evening from Tuesday to Sunday and feasted on the Word of God. The week ended with Easter Sunday, where we had nearly seventy in attendance. This links to the message that I preached to the English international ministry on Easter Sunday. Seeing our people's faith challenged was truly a blessing as we considered the purpose of our deliverance, to lead us out of bondage and into a "new and living way." It is an honor to preach and teach God's Word. As we consider **our journey over the past 28 years**, our hearts are warmed by the incredible miracles God has so clearly performed. Our hearts reflect deeply, considering the many battles the Lord led us into that challenged our faith to its core. It is evident in so many ways that Satan does not want a local church in our community. Though the "gates of Hell," i.e., the authorities of Satan, cannot prevail, they never cease to resist in every way. "For a great door and effectual is opened unto me, and **there are many adversaries**" (1 Corinthians 16:9). The local government has begun taxing our church an additional \$400 monthly. However, the laws say the church is not subject to taxation. Thank you for praying for us as we seek to navigate life, subject to a government opposed to biblical teachings.

Summer plans to impact our community include door-to-door outreach, family outreach with cookouts and the bounce house, discipleship programs, and weekly services. We will also focus on the building's infrastructure needs, as we must put another coat of paint on the roof to avoid rust. Iceland's weather is extreme. Three doors are rusted and need replacement as well as removal and replacement of screws on the exterior walls of the church. We are hosting a group of helpers in June who are coming to help with the infrastructure and outreach needs. We still pray that the Lord will provide funds to purchase needed items for the team. The goal is \$10,000. Thank you for praying about this need. In place of summer camp this year, we will also have several days of ministry hosting programs during the daytime for kids to come, learn, play, and go home. My son William and Pyllis will be doing deputation from August to October. Thank you for praying for them as they raise support. They are working with us in the church plant. Vicki and I have been blessed to help with our first grandbaby! Yes, we have been in Jacksonville, Florida, to help our daughter and her husband as they had their first baby. We will be flying back to Iceland the first week of June. Thank you for praying for us as we say goodbye in a couple of weeks. It is never easy, but it will be exponentially more difficult with the grandbaby.
